 - Muscle or body ache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Sore throat
 - Headache
 - Diarrhea
 - Nausea or vomiting
4. Have you had a fever (100.0°F or greater) in the last 24 hours?

If you answered YES to any of the questions above, please do not visit our office. Please reschedule your meeting or plan to attend the training at a future date. We also ask if you have traveled out of state within the past 5 days, please consider wearing a mask inside the building.
